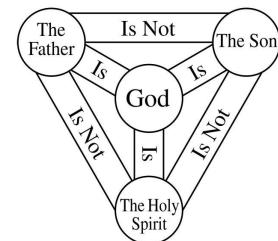




The Most Holy Trinity - John 3 16-18

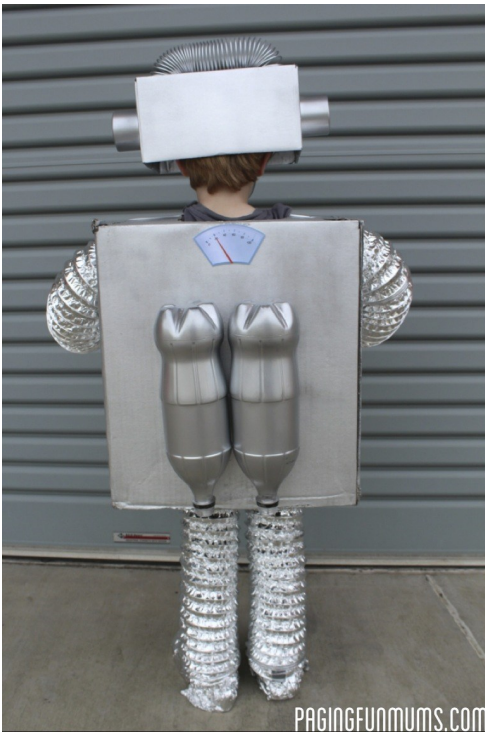
