

We follow the Religious Education Scheme called The Way, The Truth and The Life.

Children are taught approximately 2 hours of curriculum RE per week to fulfil our requirement of 10% teaching time in Catholic schools.

Children say prayers on a daily basis and plan weekly acts of worship in the classroom. They also take part in whole school collective worships during assemblies and attend Mass together at the start and end of each term.

Junior children take it in turns to attend weekly class Masses on a Thursday morning, leading the readings and prayers.

We closely follow the liturgical year wherever possible and use scripture to increase children's knowledge and understanding of the life of Jesus as well as supporting their own faith development.
